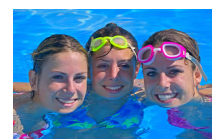

BVRI continues to operate a volunteer inspection program to monitor fire clearance and CC&R compliance.

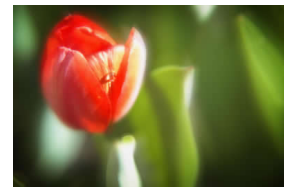
