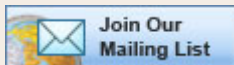

### BEAR VALLEY COMMUNITY POOL NOW OPEN!

**BVRI Members Get Free Use of The Bear Valley Lodge Pool as Membership Benefit**



The Community Pool is now open at the Bear Valley Lodge and it's ready for BVRI members to use. Haven't renewed your membership yet? [Click here to renew your membership today](#) so you can use the pool for free! (The Lodge also has membership forms so you can join BVRI or renew your BVRI membership when you go to pick up your key.)

Pool Hours are 10am-8pm daily. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent/adult guardian.

Pool-access keys will be handed out at the front desk 7 day a week, from 9am-5pm. All pool users must provide a one-time \$20 deposit for a key that may be kept until the pool closes for the season and one Bear Valley Lodge annual liability release form must be signed per family when the key is obtained.

Keys may only be picked up by BVRI members (you should be prepared to show ID when you pick up a key). A log will be kept by the lodge of BVRI members with name and assigned pool key number. A receipt for the key deposit will be provided. The Lodge will ask for an email address to send a reminder to turn in the key at the end of the season.

End of season pool closure is anticipated to be mid-September. Any members who have not turned in their keys by Oct 15th will forfeit their deposit.

## BEAR VALLEY WATER DISTRICT BOARD ELECTION NEWS

### Want to run for the BVWD Board of Directors? Declare your candidacy by August 9th.

It's an election year at the Bear Valley Water District, a California Special District which provides wastewater service in the greater Bear Valley area, including the Lake Alpine Basin and Bear Valley Mountain Resort. The election will be held in the special district on November 5, 2013.

Terms of office for 3 current directors expire December 6 including President John Dralla, Secretary Jim Bissell and Director Phil Coffman. Director's Dralla and Bissell have indicated they plan to declare their candidacy for another 4-year term, December 6, 2013 - December 1, 2017 and Director Coffman will be stepping down.

Qualified candidates must hold title to land within the District and may obtain more information as well as the official forms required to declare candidacy from the Bear Valley Water District via phone or e-mail or directly from the District office at 441 Creekside Drive in Bear Valley during regular business hours, Monday - Friday 9am - 4pm.

The filing time to declare candidacy is the period July 15 - August 9, 2013. Completed forms must be filed directly with the Office of the Alpine County Clerk no later than 5pm on August 9, 2013 at 99 Water Street, Markleeville, CA, 96120.
