To resolve any doubt, we are asking that members (and guests of members) bring their membership cards along for both fishing and other recreational uses of the lake. If members wish to allow their guests to use their membership cards, of course, that's wonderful. The more use and enjoyment we can attain from the lake, the better; however, it will be incumbent upon each member to make sure their guests have the card.

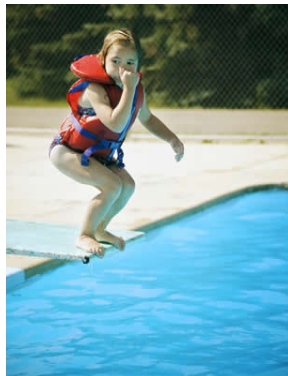
