Parking Properly Means the Groomers Can Do Their Job!

Please be aware of the importance of properly parking your snowmobile off the groomed roadways. Now that winter is here and the roads are being groomed, it is your responsibility as a snowmobile owner to make sure your machine is properly parked off the roadway.

If you live on a narrow street or on a curve it is even more important to leave plenty of room as the snowcat is very wide and any obstruction in the roadway may prevent the groomer from getting through to the rest of your neighbors. If your cabin is on a downhill slope and

you can't park your snowmobile completely off the roadway, reach out to the groomer for a solution that works best for both of you so the roads will be clear for all.

If you have an issue, you may contact the sheriff's office. They may have some useful suggestions as well if you have a particularly challenging snowmobile parking situation near your cabin. The sheriff would much rather help you figure out a workable solution, than issue a ticket later in the winter season!
