

### **Bear Valley Residential Chipper Program**

#### **Residential Chipping Program 2023 Instructions**

**Bear Valley and the Alpine County properties in Sherman Acres** are eligible for a grant funded Residential Chipper Program through the Alpine County Fire Safe Council to provide a No-Cost Defensible Space Chipping Program for residents willing to work together to be fire safe. Please follow the instructions listed below, then, turn in the Request for Chipping Form and the Hold Harmless Agreement. This program can be applied for starting July 1 through September 30, 2023. Your applications will be accepted on a first come first served basis. The chipping will be performed on approved chipper piles during various weeks through the end of September.

- 1. Place organized brush piles adjacent to a driveway or street, preferably within 5 feet of the road. The overall height of the pile should not exceed 4 feet. PLEASE DO NOT PLACE PILES ON THE COUNTY ROADS OR IN COUNTY DITCHES.
- 2. Cut Ends must face in the same direction and pointing out towards the road or driveway.
- 3. No individual branches or limbs over 6 inches in diameter.
- 4. No piles of leaves, pinecones, pine needles, yard clippings, duff, small twigs, or bark will be chipped.
- 5. Please keep all piles free of rocks, Mountain White Thorn (Ceanothus cordulatus, aka buckbrush), thorny bushes or vines, mud, wire, large pieces of bark, lumber, nails, and pinecones. Any signs of such materials in your piles will cause the chipping work to stop.
- 6. You need not be home for services to take place.
- 7. The Fire Safe Council requires an "Application for Chipping" (Attachment 1) and a "Hold Harmless Agreement" (Attachment 2) to be submitted before an inspection will be completed on your property. Please turn in your application after your piles have been completed and are ready for inspection.
- 8. Homeowners shall not perform any work the day of the chipping and shall stay a minimum of 30 feet from the chipping operation.

#### **Hold Harmless Agreement for the 2023 Chipper Program**

To Whom It May Concern:

I give my commitment to participate with the Alpine County Fire Safe Council (ACFSC) in the 2023 Residential Chipper Program. I will participate freely in the project.

By Signing below, I agree to the following:

- 1. I consent to allow the ACFSC private contractor on my property.
- 2. I agree to have the material chipped back onto my property.
- 3. I understand that the contractor has the final authority in determining if the piles are suitable for chipping.
- 4. I understand that if the pile is not prepared to our instructions and specifications, it will not be chipped.
- 5. I agree to comply with the contractor's decision about where to place the chips, as safety is their number one concern.
- 6. The landowner will hold harmless the ACFSC and any other entity involved in this project in connection with any loss or liability or injury to persons or property that arise from performance of work under this agreement. ACFSC will hold harmless the Landowner (and any contracting entity in this project) in connection with any loss or liability or injury to persons or property that arise from performance of work under this agreement. Work crews will have liability insurance (provided by ACFSC or contracting entity) for work on Landowner's property.

The term of this agreement shall be from July 1 to September 30, 2023. This agreement can be amended only by prior written notification of either party executing this agreement.
