Bear Lake Do's and Don'ts


for a Safe and Enjoyable Beach Experience

Do's:

Check-In with the Beach Attendant Upon Arrival: Beach use is for BVRI members and their guests only.



Use Tents/Canopies Considerately: Ensure others have clear visibility of the beach and lake.



✓ Use Reef Compliant Sunscreen: Help keep our lake clean and safe.



Dispose of Trash Properly: Pick up your garbage and sort it into the correct bins.



✓ Store Watercraft in the Racks Provided (Big Beach): If racks are full, store watercraft off to the side and out of the way of others.



Don'ts:

X No Dogs or Pets Allowed in Lake or on Beach: Please leave your furry friends at home.




✗ No Motorized Watercraft are Allowed on Bear Lake: Please keep sailboats to 10 mph or less.



✗ Do Not "Borrow" Boats or Oars/Paddles: Boats, SUPs, and their oars are private property and not for communal use, even if unlocked.



✗ No Drones: For safety and privacy, drones are not permitted at Bear Lake.



★ Do Not Block Others' View of the Lake with Large Closed Canopies or Tents: Please be considerate and set these up off to the side.



Do Not Leave Tents/Canopies overnight: Please remove from the Beach at the end of each day.



✗ Do Not Fish from the Beach or the Swimming Platform: Please find a safe spot on the trail away from swimmers and boaters.
